

How to Turn Off Pop Up Blockers in Firefox and Microsoft Edge

A Quick Guide for UCSF Faculty, Staff, and Trainees at ZSFG






Step 1: Open the **Tools** menu (icon of three horizontal lines in top right of the browser window) and select **Options**




Step 3: Scroll down to the **Permissions** heading, uncheck **Block pop-up windows**, and close the window






