

How to Turn Off Pop Up Blockers in Firefox and Microsoft Edge

A Quick Guide for UCSF Faculty, Staff, and Trainees at ZSFG





Step 1: Open the **Tools** menu (icon of three horizontal lines in top right of the browser window) and select **Settings**


Mandatory Training Requirement

(Ctrl+P), Save page as... (Ctrl+S), Find in page... (Ctrl+F), Zoom (100%), Settings, More tools, Help, Exit (Ctrl+Shift+Q)

- Ctrl+Tab cycles through tabs in recently used order
- Open links in tabs instead of new windows
- When you open a link in a new tab, switch to it immediately
- Show tab preview in the Windows toolbar




Step 3: Scroll down to the **Permissions** heading, uncheck **Block pop-up windows**, and close the window






