

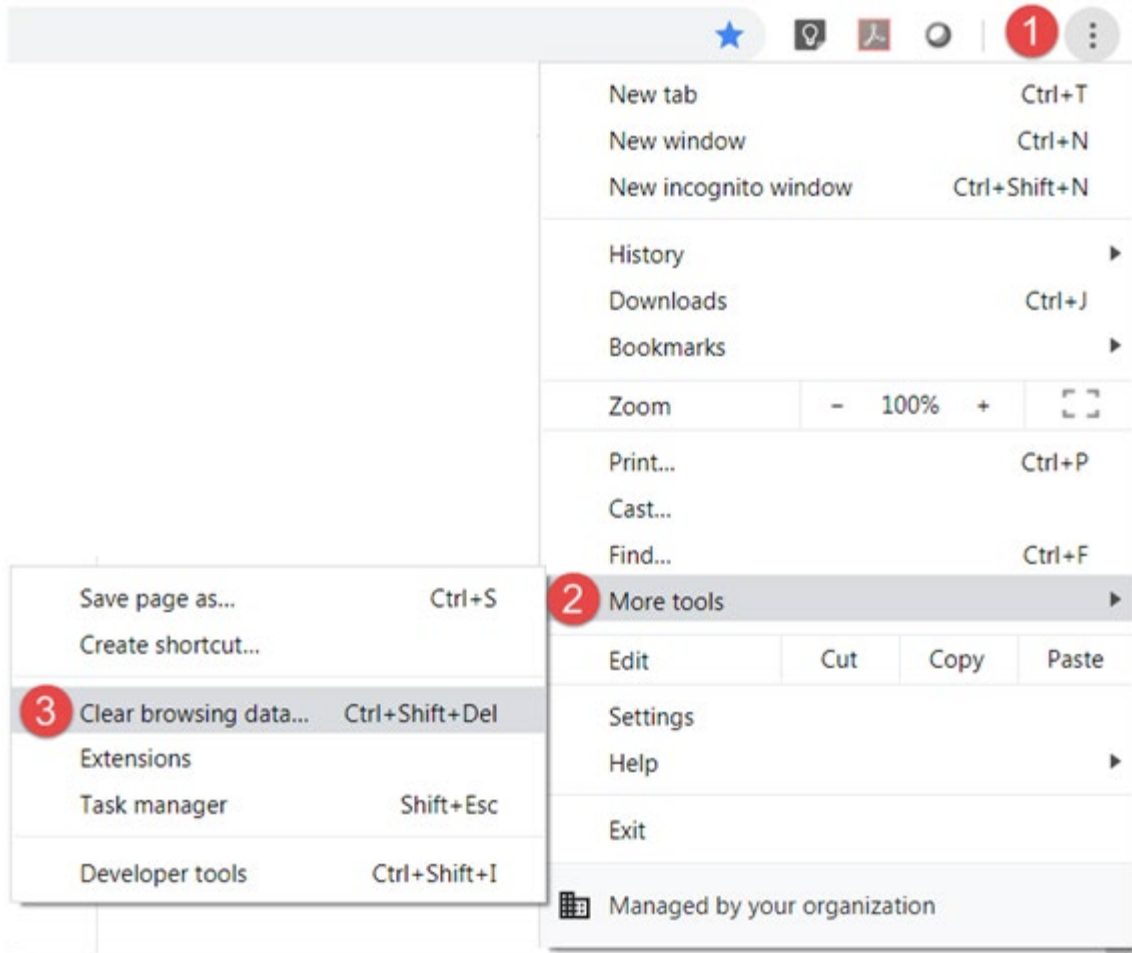
# How do I clear my browser cache?

Instructions below for Chrome, Firefox, Edge, and Safari browsers. As Microsoft no longer supports security updates for the Internet Explorer, **please do not use Internet Explorer to access Citywide applications.**

Please contact your Department IT staff if you need assistance clearing your cache or installing Firefox or Chrome.

## Google Chrome

- 1) Open your Chrome browser and click the **menu** (3 dots) in the top right corner
- 2) Select **More tools**
- 3) Click **Clear browsing data** (or use the keyboard shortcut Ctrl+Shift+Del to jump straight to step 4)
- 4) Click **Advanced**
- 5) For **Time range**, select **All time**
- 6) Select all items to ensure all data and files are cleared
- 7) Click **Clear data**
- 8) Under **Privacy and security**, click **Site Settings**
- 9) Click **Cookies and site data**
- 10) Turn on **Clear cookies and site data when you quit Chrome** to ensure your cache is cleared after each browser session

# Firefox

- 1) Open your Firefox browser and click the **menu** in the top right corner
- 2) Click **Options** (or **Preferences**)

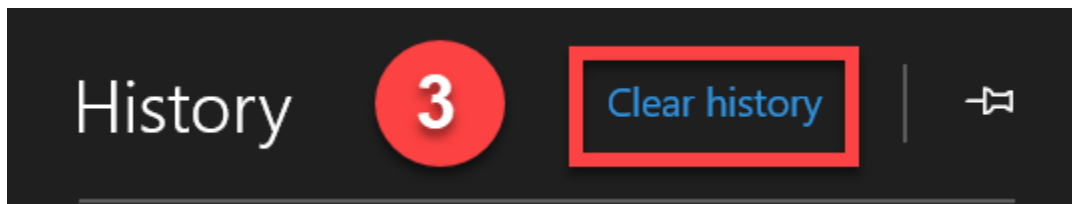
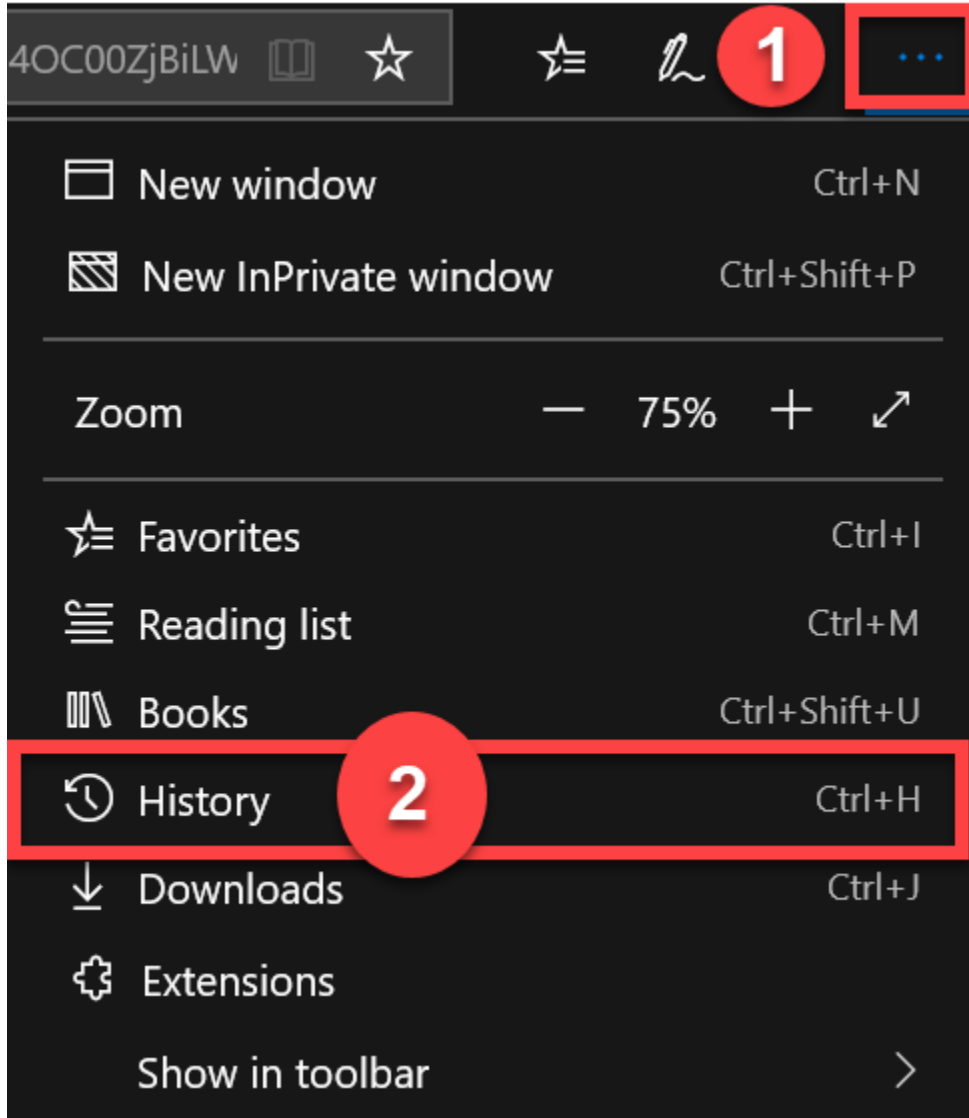
- 3) Click **Privacy & Security**
- 4) Under "Cookies and Site Data" click **Clear Data...**
- 5) Check **Cookies and Site Data** and **Cached Web Content**
- 6) Click **Clear**





## Microsoft Edge

- 1) Open your Edge browser and click the **menu** (3 dots) in the top right corner
- 2) Click **History**
- 3) Click **Clear History**
- 4) Check **Browsing History**, **Cookies and saved website data**, **Cached data and files**, **Tabs I've set aside or recently closed**, and **Download history**
- 5) Click **Clear**
- 6) Turn on **Always clear this when I close the browser** to ensure all data and files are cleared after each browser session.

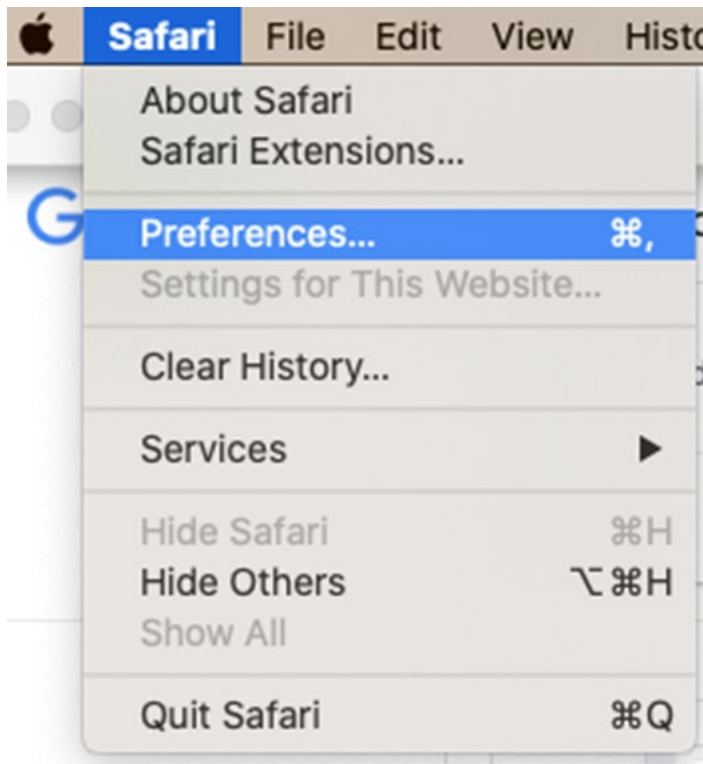

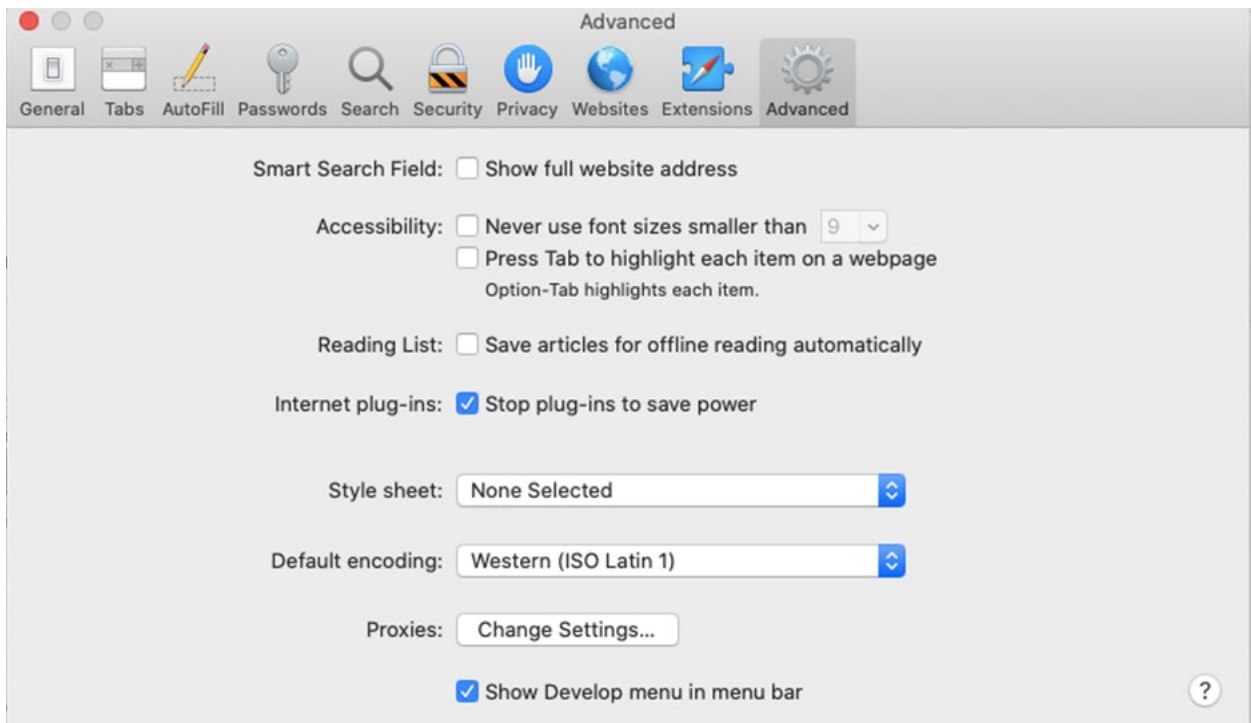

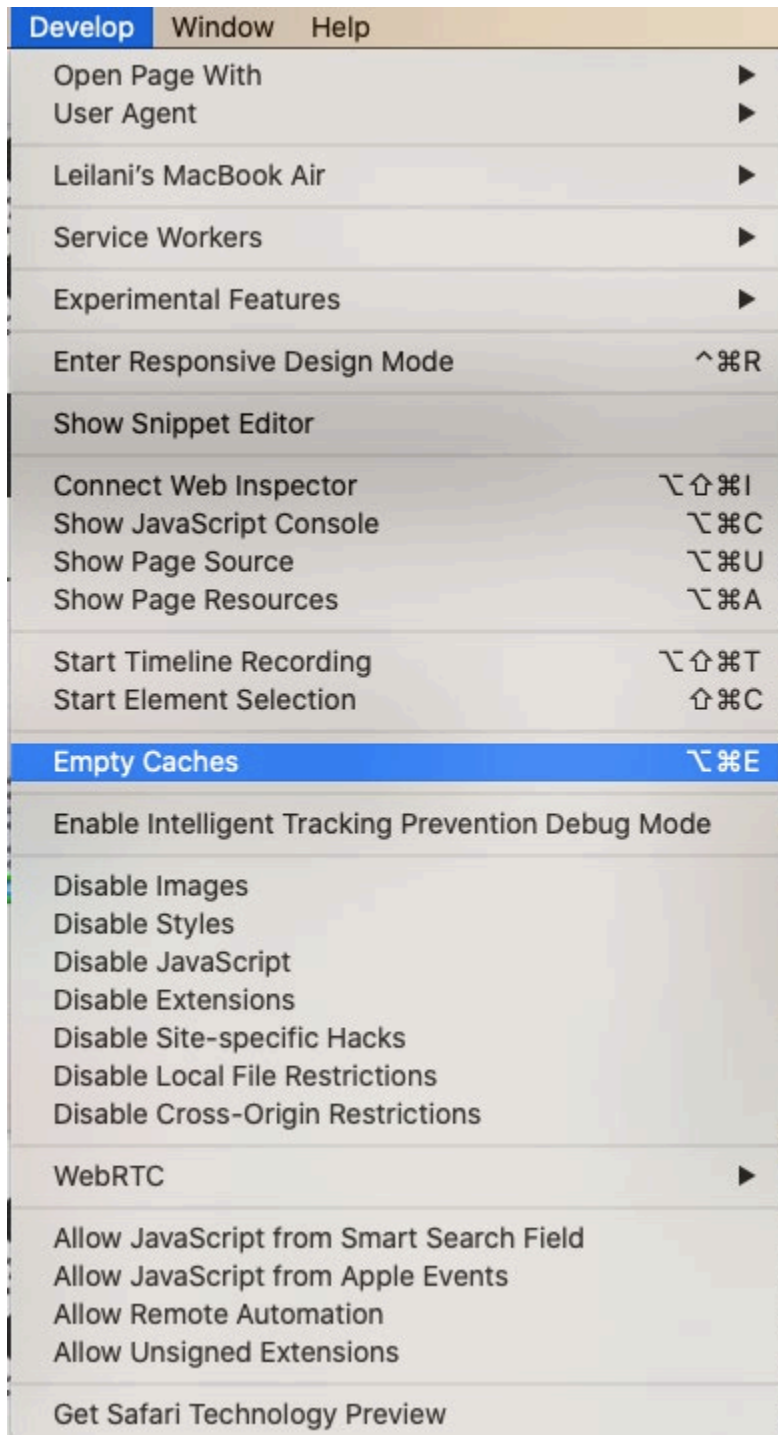


# Safari

- 3) Click the **Advanced** icon
- 4) Select **Show Develop menu in the menu bar**
- 5) Navigate back to Safari and click **Develop** in the menu bar
- 6) Click **Empty Caches**

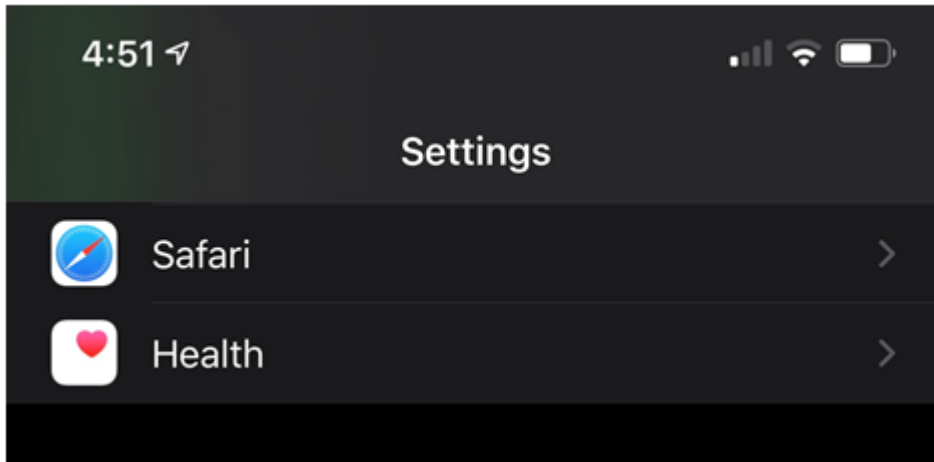




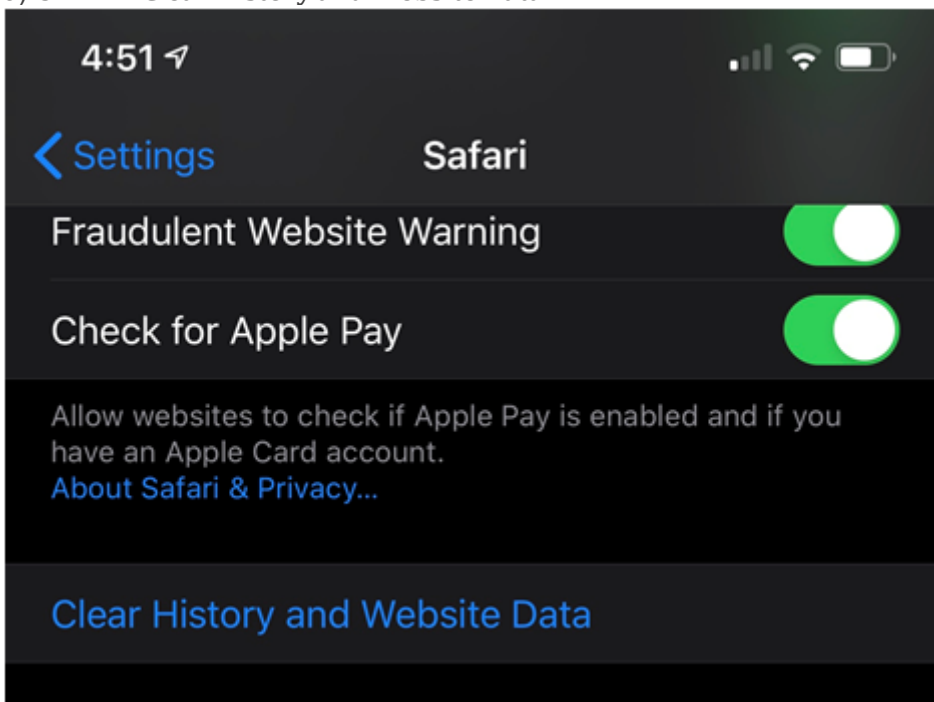


## Safari on iPhone
